

2023 Suez Shrine Director J.D Smelser

Hello Suez, it has been a while. Claudia and I are doing well in El Salvador and we are gearing up for the Shrine Director's Association this April in Ohio and the Imperial Session this July in Charlotte, NC. As a kid hauling the Director's Staff Cadillac all over the country with my parents. Over the past 41 years, being a Noble and a Voting Delegate Emeritus, I have been honored to attend over 25 Imperial Sessions. This year's Imperial Session will be my 8th appointment to the Imperial Marshal's Aides Committee. Some people have asked why. So, I thought I'd explain three reasons the Imperial Shrine Session is worth attending.

- 1. **Friendships**: The Imperial Shrine Session is a perfect opportunity for you and your family to meet other Nobles and families from around the world who believe in the Fraternity and the cause of Shriners Children's. The Nobles from the Philippines usually come in full force, Mexico and Panama typically have had a strong presence as does Emirate Shriners out of Germany. If you are not sitting in business meetings or serving on a committee, it is really a fun and relaxing few days. The host city always has places to see, events around town and it is close to the 4th of July so you can usually expect good fireworks shows. Suez and other TSA Temples usually host a hospitality room with food and refreshments at the Suez hotel which is open for members of Suez and family.
- 2. Imperial Market Place and Unit Competitions: The Imperial Session marketplace houses vendors where you can purchase anything Shriners, Shriners Children's or Freemasonry. There are also many other vendors with items to purchase such as flag poles, parade vehicles, jewelry, antiques, cigars, and so much more! The marketplace also gives you the opportunity to investigate and support members of many of our appendant bodies. The Imperial session also provides units an opportunity to compete against other temples at the Imperial Level including some of my favorite unit competitions like the Provost Guard, Mounted Horse Patrol, Patrol, Keystone Clowns, Highlanders and Oriental Bands. Texas's own Khiva Shriners holds some of the best bragging rights in the Oriental Band competition and usually brings home the gold.
- 3. Imperial Parade: While the Imperial Parade might not be the 11th hour parade that it use to be in the mid 1980's, it still typically runs for three to four hours. I have had the opportunity to serve on the Parade Pit Crew where I help organize the parade and get to see some of the most magnificent and incredible Shriner parade vehicles. Because the location changes annually, we get a mix of vehicles that are new and others that have been seen at multiple Imperial sessions. Some of those top units for me are the Jerusalem Motorcycle Corp out of the New Orleans area, the Dragon out of Minnesota, the Lobster Boats of Anah Shriners of Maine, a new favorite, the Alzafar Red Wagon and an old time favorite, the Suez Fire Truck. One question often asked of the Pit Crew is how do we decide the line up? The simple answer is, we do not! Each Shrine Temple is lined up in order by date of Charter after the units of the Shrine Temples of the Imperial Officers by rank. The first Shrine Temple after the Imperial Officers will always be Mecca. Unfortunately, when Suez was charted in 1951, we were the 161st charter so that's our parade number unless we have an Imperial Officer for Suez or a Texas Imperial Potentate requests TSA units to parade together. Even though their wait is long, Temples from the Philippines and Germany enjoy walking around taking photos, checking out all the parade unit's, making new friends and even helping the pit crew locate participating units. It's a tough committee assignment working the pit crew for the parade, but it's an honor to represent Suez while working with a great group of Nobles. When considering your summer family vacation, I hope you will consider Charlotte, NC July first through fifth for the 149th Imperial Shrine Session


