

I hope this message finds you well. It brings me great pleasure to share with you the exciting news and updates from our recent endeavors.


Over the past year, under the esteemed leadership of Illustrious Sir Sheldon Claborn, we have achieved remarkable progress and experienced a year filled with prosperity.



#### SUBJECT: Per Capita Tax Increase

The per capita tax increase of \$20.00 passed at the recently concluded Imperial Session. Pursuant to the provisions of \$331.5(a) of the bylaws of Shriners International:

"When a change is made by Shriners International affecting Shrine law, and the change affects the bylaws of any temple, the bylaws of the temple are changed, ipso facto, to conform with those of Shriners International."

Therefore, it is important to understand that no change in the temple bylaws is required to have the per capita tax become immediately effective and the dues notices will go out with the appropriate sums itemized on the due's notices. The temple is not responsible for making any changes to WebFez regarding the per capita increase. This will be addressed by Fraternal Information Services at Shriners International.

While §331.5(b) of the bylaws of Shriners International does require those temples who have their dues amounts set forth in their temple bylaws to amend their bylaws, that does not become effective until General Order No. 1 is issued (likely in September 2023).

We will provide you with additional information related to the per capita tax increase and how that will be identified in communications during the coming dues cycle at a subsequent point.

This memo is intended only to make the point that the change in the Imperial bylaws related to the per capita tax <u>does not</u> require the immediate amendment of temple bylaws by those temples whose bylaws include dues amounts.




