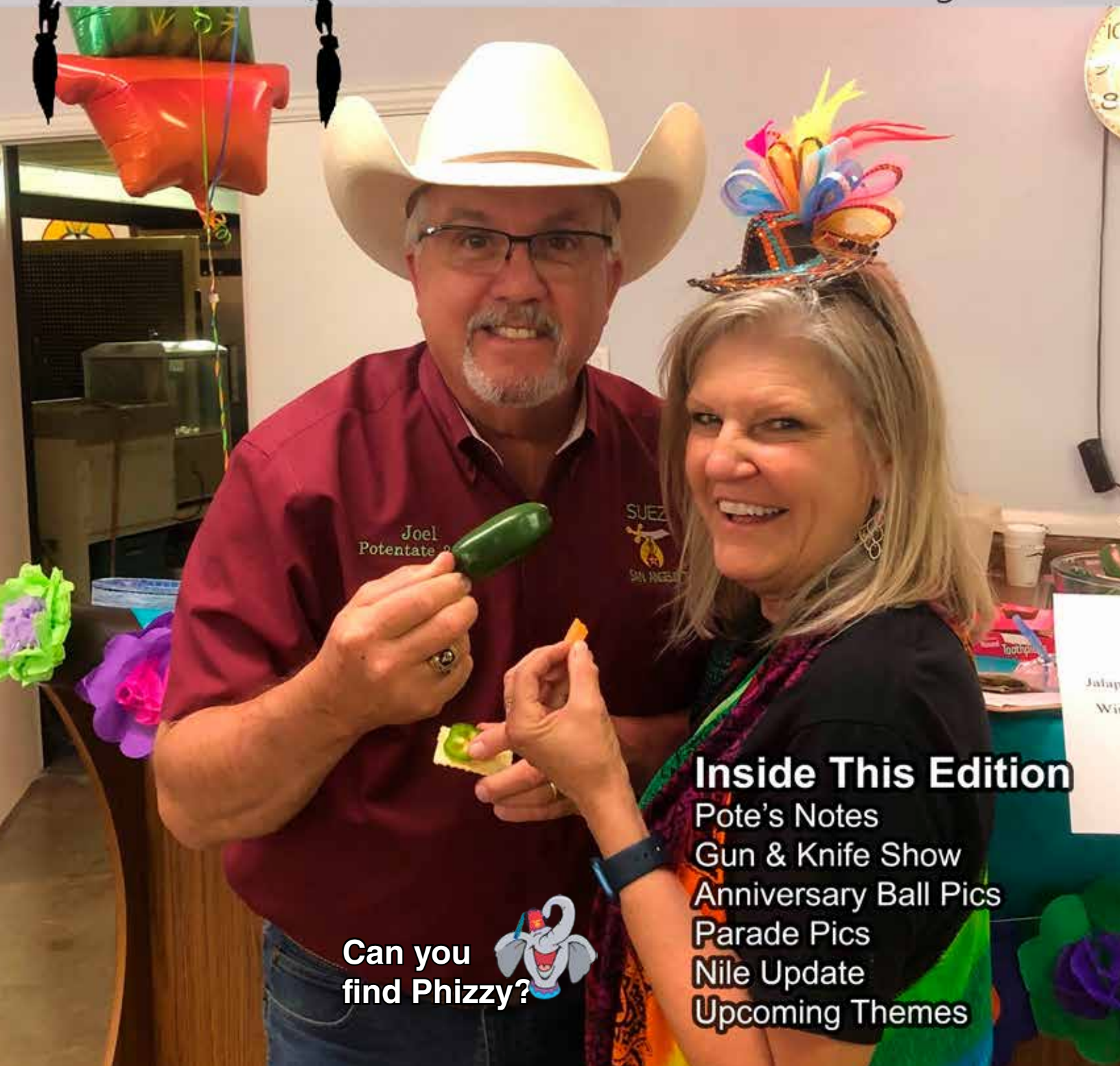

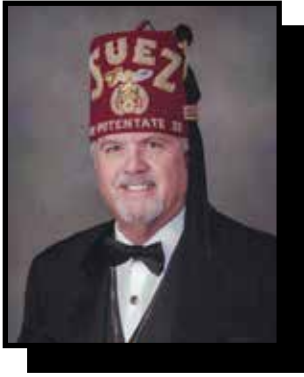

## By-Laws Change Notification

All Nobles of Suez Temple are notified that resolutions will be presented to amend the By-Laws of Suez Temple adopted on January 20, 2021. The resolutions will be presented to the Nobility in a written format in the June 20, 2022, Stated Meeting and held over without discussion until voted on in the July 18, 2022 Stated Meeting. Any discussion will take place in the July 18 meeting. A vote of 2/3 of the membership present in the July meeting will be required to pass these Resolution of Amendment. An official copy of the resolutions will be available in the Recorder's office. Stated meeting starts at 7:30pm, a 2022 Shrine Membership card is required to attend the meeting. Every Noble is encouraged to attend these meeting. Official notice is given in the June issue of the Scribbling and mailed letter prior to the July 18, 2022 meeting.

### **AMENDMENTS OF BYLAWS: Article 5 Section 5.2**

Reads now

Dues. The annual dues shall be determined at a stated meeting of the temple after notice has been given to each member stating the proposed amount of the annual dues. The annual dues shall not be less than prescribed by the bylaws of Shrine International. The annual dues do not include the hospital levy, or the annual per capital tax required by the bylaws of Shriners International, each of which shall be added to the annual dues. The temple may, by affirmative vote, remit dues of a member for good cause shown either to the temple or a committee selected for that purpose.

### **Resolution Change**

Dues. The annual dues shall be determined at a stated meeting of the temple after notice has been given to each member stating the proposed amount of the annual dues. The annual dues shall not be less than prescribed by the bylaws of Shrine International. The annual dues shall be \$100. The annual dues do not include the hospital levy, or the annual per capital tax required by the bylaws of Shriners International, each of which shall be added to the annual dues. The temple may, by affirmative vote, remit dues of a member for good cause shown either to the temple or a committee selected for that purpose.
