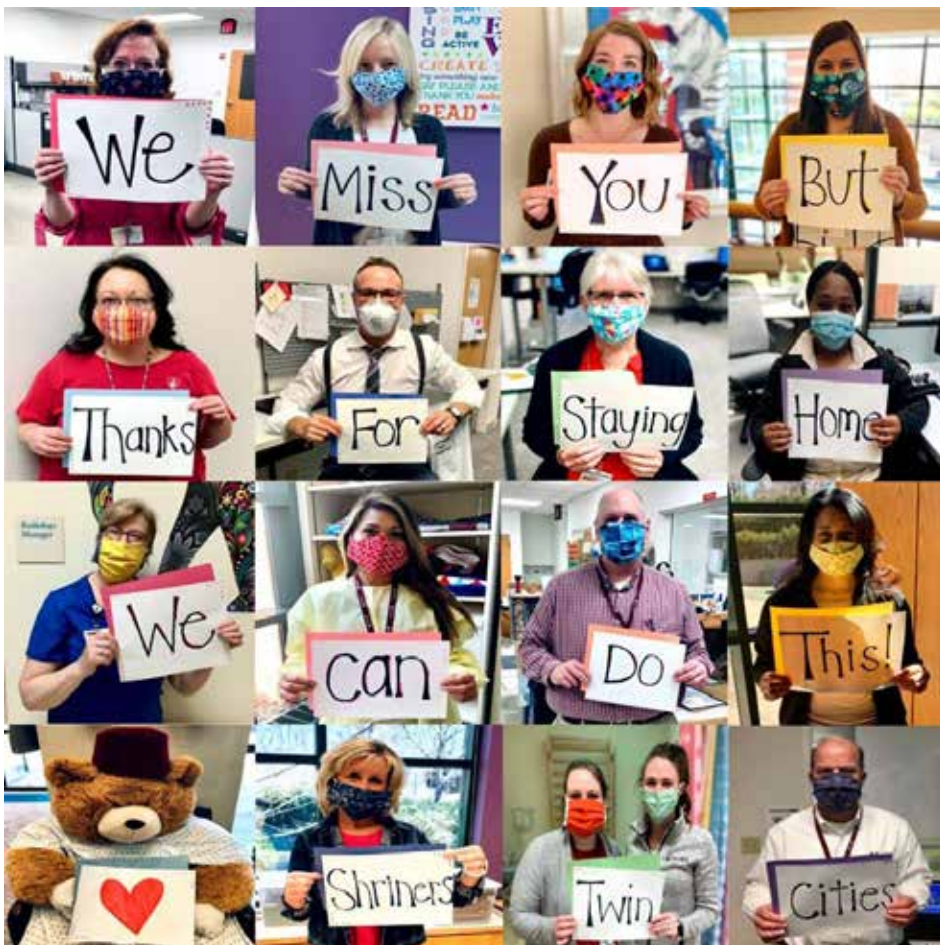






## NASCAR

There has also been some concern raised over how the name will function with its possessive ending. The brand will be used as a master brand with a more specific label following. 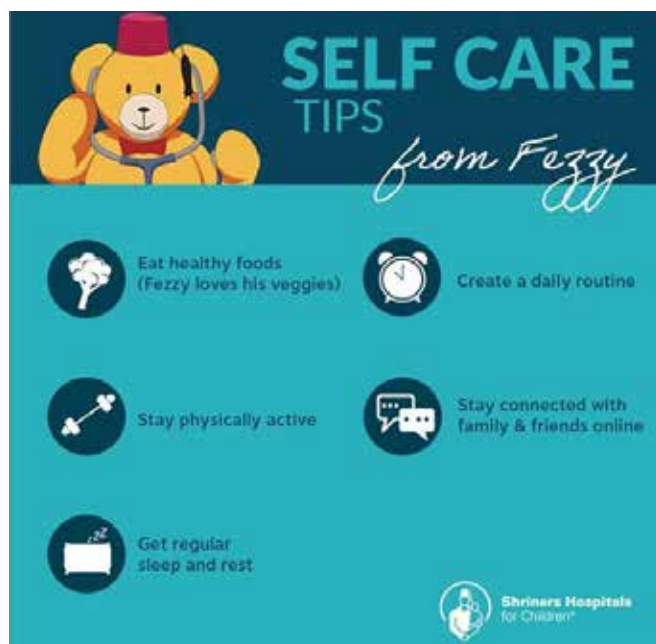

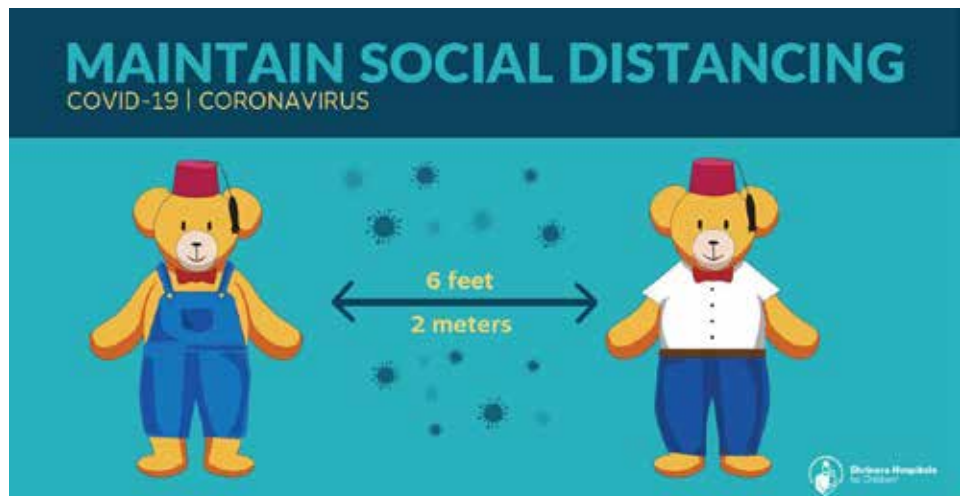
