

Meet April's Patient of the Month, Luke—a bright 4-year-old with an endless imagination. Luke has spent just over a month in the inpatient rehabilitation unit and is already drastically improving his abilities.

When Luke arrived at Shriners Houston, he had poor trunk control when sitting; he could stand with assistance but with weight bearing mainly on his right leg, and only able to take a few steps. Some of the focus of his physical training included locomotor training, neuromuscular re-education and balance. With occupational therapy, he is also achieving fine motor skills and improving his self-care abilities.

Luke is now walking everywhere with a walker, is able to stand on dynamic surfaces and improving his balance and core strength. We are very proud of all his hard work and how he faces each challenge with a fun attitude. Way to go Luke!
