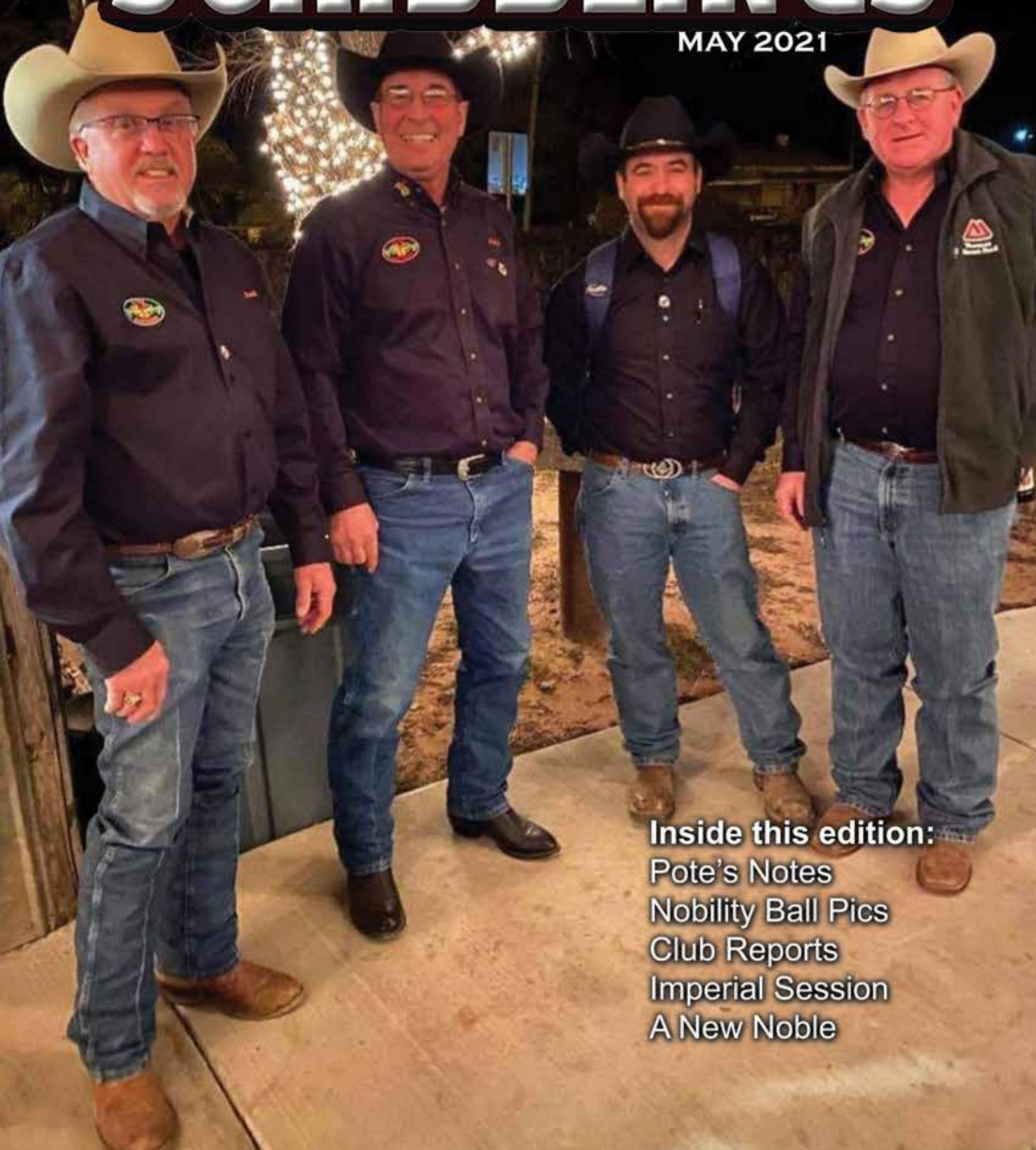

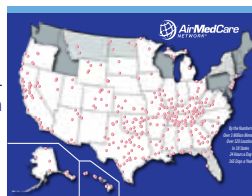

Past Queen Elizabeth “Betty” Johnson, long time member of Daughters of the Nile, Ziphron Temple No. 100, has earned one of the highest honors bestowed upon a Daughter of the Nile, the John McHenry Award. The McHenry Award is presented to Ladies who have contributed to the Daughters of the Nile Foundation by:

- Donating a minimum of \$5,000 in cash or the equivalent value in assets to the Foundation Convalescent Endowment Fund (CEF) or the Convalescent Relief Account.
- Supporting the mission of the Foundation with their efforts of being actively involved in fundraising activities.

Past Queen Betty was initiated on May 16, 1988 . She served as Ziphron’s Queen in 1993 and again in 2013. A total of 64 new members initiated due to her influence. 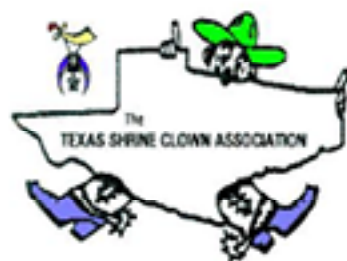
