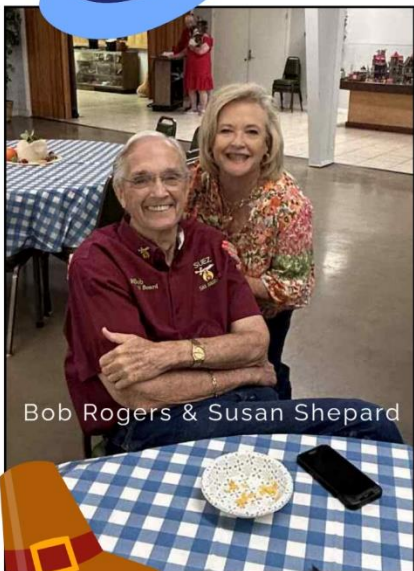

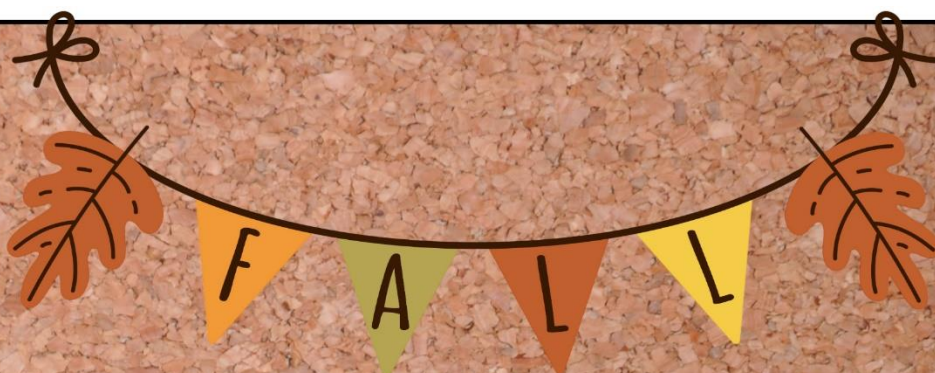

What does the Fez mean and Why do Shriners wear a Fez?

- The Fez was chosen because the Shriners' theme is rooted in Arabian (Near-Eastern) culture. The fraternity was founded by Masons who were inspired by an exotic, Arabian-themed party.
- The hat itself is named after the city of Fez, Morocco, where it was first manufactured and worn by students as an insignia.
- Since its adoption in 1872, the fez has served as the official head covering for Shriners International members during official activities, meetings, parades, and other related events
- It makes members easily identifiable as Shriners, creating a visual connection among fellow members in public.

Symbolic Meaning for Shriners

- Brotherhood & Unity: The fez signifies unity among Shriners across the globe, creating a sense of family and belonging.
- Commitment to Charity: The hat is visible representation of a Shriner's lifelong commitment to philanthropy and giving. It stands for their dedication to supporting Shriner Children's and making the world a kinder place
- Tradition and Integrity: As an emblem passed down through generations, the red fez represents the integrity, dedication, and service that are core to the family's values.

Nobles need to Remember what a fez means and why they wear it!



When a member of a Shrine Temple is interested in running for a position on the Board of Directors, he needs to be completely aware of what is expected of him. When running for a position on the Divan, a candidate should know upfront what the obligations and duties of that office require. This letter is to explain those obligations and duties, so you do not have any misunderstandings during your term of office.

- He first should be a Master Mason in good standing.
- His devotion to Freemasonry should be constant in his representation of his Temple as well as his Blue Lodge.
- He should devote himself to the duties that come with office of the Divan.
- He is a representative of the Nobility and should be able to express himself clearly and correctly when it comes to Temple business
- He must have leadership capabilities and be influential to everyone he encounters.
- He must have good character and be open to investigation.
- A candidate must understand that if elected he has obligated himself to serve the time that comes with the office of the Divan.
- His progression through this journey will advance him one day to the position of Illustrious Potentate.
- As a member of the Divan, he should be at all meetings when called upon.
- When the Temple events are scheduled, the Divan should be there as a united group representing leadership and responsibility.
- He should devote ample time to his duties as an officer of the Temple Divan and do so with vitality and energy.

Being a member of the Temple Divan is a great honor and comes with tremendous responsibilities. He will devote a great deal of his time to the betterment of the Temple and to Shriner's. A member who is interested in becoming a Divan Officer must understand that some sacrifices are involved. Sacrificing your time, financial security and personal life only comes with the satisfaction of a tremendous job well done.

ELECTION CALL

The annual election of officers of Suez Shrine Temple and of Representatives to the 2026 Imperial Council Session will be held at the December Stated Meeting, on December 15, 2026 at the Suez Temple located at 2915 Loop 306 San Angelo, TX 79604. The Stated Meeting will begin at 7:30pm. Voting members must be in "Good Standing" and must present a Shrine Card before being admitted.

The following section of the bylaws of the Imperial Council, Shriners International, is quoted for information and compliance:
§325.11 Election Regulations.

(a) Electioneering

A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine Temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidate for office in the temple is prohibited.

(b) Expenditures Prohibited

The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.

(c) Violation

For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officer's void and order a new election.

At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

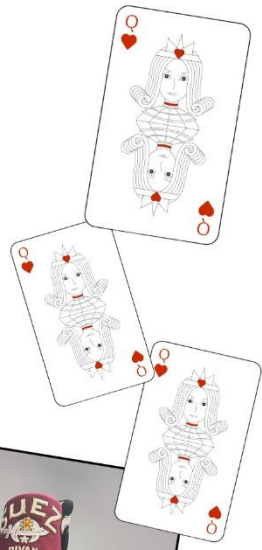
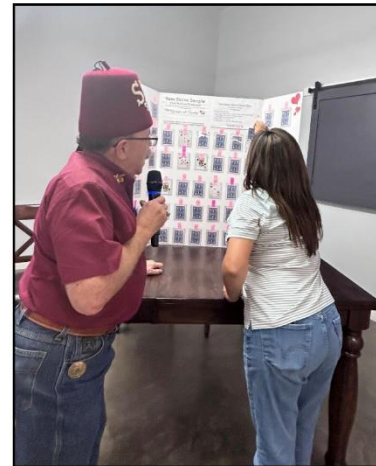

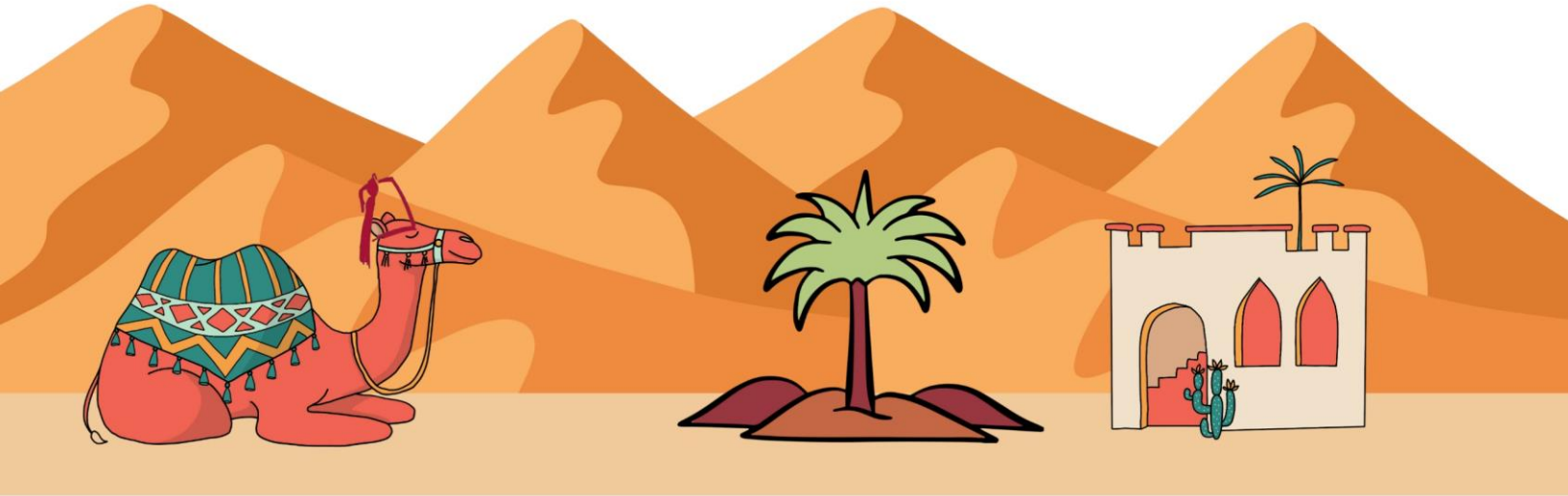
